This seminar is to teach the participants how to handle dogs. It is not a training session for your dog. Therefore, it is to your advantage to have an older, more trained dog present. You may alternate two dogs if you wish.

Mr. Vroom works with each class for one hour at a time, during which the opposite class is practicing in another area. There will be a competition on Sunday following the lesson – be prepared with proper show attire! Best Handler at Seminar, and Best in Show will be awarded as well.

Mr. Vroom has had over 750 Best in Shows, and over 2000 Group 1s. He was originally licensed as an All-Breed Handler in 1966. He has handled four Quaker Oats winners and seven Garden Group winners. He has handled three dogs to Top Dog All-Breed, was voted Fido Dog Handler of the Year two times and Kennel Review Dog Handler of the Year two times.

**Advanced:** 5 years previous handling experience or at least handled two dogs to their championship. ( limited to 15 people )

**Beginners:** Must be at least 10 years of age, dogs over one year ( limited to 15 people )

**Observers:** anyone interested in learning proper handling skills, no dogs please.
